Health Kits and Flood Buckets are needed to replenish our depleted supply.

Flood Buckets

5 gallon bucket with re-sealable lid	1 scrub brush	18 cleaning towels (reusable)
Disinfectant dish soap (16-28 oz. bottle)	50 clothes pins	Clothes line (two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.)
5 scouring pads	1 pair work gloves	1 household cleaner (12-16 oz. bottle)
5 dust masks	7 sponges	2 pair latex gloves
Bleach (two 1-quart bottles or one 82 oz. bottle)		
Liquid laundry detergent (two 25 oz. or one 50 oz bottle)		
24 bag roll of heavy duty trash bags—33-45 gallon (remove roll from box before placing in bucket)		
1 insect repellent spray--6-14 oz. can (if aerosol, cans must have protective caps)		
1 air freshener, 8 oz. can or larger (if aerosol, cans must have protective caps)		

Health Kits

Put all items in a 1 gallon sealable plastic bag

1 hand towel (15"x25" up to 17"x27", no kitchen towels)	1 washcloth
1 comb (large and sturdy, not pocket-sized)	1 nail file (no emery boards)
1 fingernail clippers (no toenail clippers)	1 bath size bar of soap (3 oz. and up)
1 toothbrush (in original wrapper, no child size brushes)	6 band aids
1 bottle hand sanitizer	\$1 to purchase toothpaste
